

David Cargill House is a Grade 'A' listed "Greek" Thomson building, located in the heart of the West End of Glasgow, surrounded by parks, gardens and churches.

We are within easy reach of the city centre, close to public transport and within walking distance to the local shops. The motorway network for Glasgow, Stirling, Edinburgh, Ayrshire and Dumbarton regions are also easily reached.

The House was converted in 1951 for use as a "Residential Home for Older Adults," and has accommodation for 45 residents with 21 single and 12 double rooms available.

David Cargill House is a voluntary, non profit making organisation, administered by Glasgow Old People's Welfare Association, and registered with The Scottish Commission for the Regulation of Care (The Care Commission), Glasgow City Council and The Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC). These organisations ensure that the Home's high standards are maintained. The home is operated in accordance with the Care Commission's National Care Standards and Glasgow City Council's national Care Contract.

The Home is staffed 24 hours a day, by a caring and dedicated staff team, who endeavour to maintain high standards of care in a homely atmosphere.

Residents are encouraged to bring their personal effects, and add their own personal touch to their room.

A high standard of resident care is provided at all times, with an excellent staff skill mix.

Our Chefs can provide for a full range of dietary requirements and are able to cater for any special needs. There is a varied menu at each sitting, including a buffet breakfast. Fresh fruits and juices are offered throughout the day. Meal times are flexible with wine and other refreshments available on request.


